303.1 ADMINISTRATION - PURPOSE

1. The Board of School Directors of the Turkeyfoot Valley Area School District believes the purpose of school administrators is to create a learning atmosphere conducive to the fullest development of each student enrolled in the public schools of the District; therefore, an administrative staff shall be elected by the Board of School Directors to serve this end.
2. The Board of School Directors shall, by a majority vote of all the members thereof, elect a properly qualified person as a District Superintendent, as it deems wise. In May of each year the School Directors shall evaluate the Superintendent during the Act 93 meeting.
3. The Board of School Directors shall delegate to the Superintendent the administration of all policies. As the chief administrative officer, the Superintendent shall be responsible for the proper interpretation of such policies and in turn he shall delegate to his assistants, the staff, and others responsible to him, such portion of the policies which pertain to the various activities of the school program. When doubt exists as to the interpretation of the policy, the matter shall be referred to the Board for final interpretation.
4. As representatives of the District, The Board of School Directors will consider the wishes of the taxpayers and consider recommendations of the Administration as it formulates policy for operation. Being trained in matters of public education, the Administration is charged with the responsibility of advising the Board concerning what actions are appropriate considering the education of young people. This is not, however, intended to diminish the power or responsibilities of the School Board.
